The last years of USSR relive in the reports of journalist Fabio Galvano from “La Stampa”, witness in Moscow of the events that brought to an end the largest empire in history.

When the red flags were lowered from the Kremlin, on December 25th 1991, the world witnessed an epocal change. 74 years after the Bolshevik revolution the great empire disintegrated with an irreverent ease. The fall of the Soviet Union was a surprise to many, but in the years when Andropov, Chernenko and Gorbachev were in power all the signs were already in place. Fabio Galvano analyses them in these pages, where journalism becomes history.

For over twenty years **Fabio Galvano** was correspondent for the daily “La Stampa” first in Moscow, then in Brussels, and eventually in London. He is the author of several historical essays that accompanied his journalistic activity.
