Ettore Cinnella taught for many years Contemporary History at the University of Pisa. He is considered Italy's major expert in Russian Studies. Among his books: 1917. *La Russia verso l'abisso* and 1905. *La vera rivoluzione russa*.

From the secret archives of the former Soviet Union the truth emerges about Stalin's most terrible crime.

Between autumn 1932 and spring 1933 six million farmers in the USSR were sentenced to die of starvation: nearly two-thirds of the victims were Ukrainians. That famine of unprecedented proportions was not due to the vagaries of nature, but was orchestrated by Stalin to punish the rebels that, throughout USSR, opposed the collectivization campaign. In Ukraine the extermination of peasants, the so-called holodomor, intertwined with the persecution of the intelligentsia and the war against the patriotic feelings of an entire nation.

Leaning on the evidence emerged after the collapse of the USSR, the book reconstructs those dramatic events and explains the reasons that led Stalin to make such ruthless decisions.
